Paragraph 11.24 of the Section 182 Guidance of the Licensing Act 2003 states that;

A number of reviews may arise in connection with crime that is not directly connected with licensable activities. For example, reviews may arise because of drugs problems at the premises, money laundering by criminal gangs, the sale of contraband or stolen goods, the sale of firearms, or the sexual exploitation of children. Licensing authorities do not have the power to judge the criminality or otherwise of any issue. This is a matter for the courts. The licensing authorities role when determining such a review is not therefore to establish guilt or innocence of the individual but to ensure the promotion of the licensing objectives.

Paragraph 11.25 states that Reviews are part of the regulatory process introduced by the 2003 Act and they are not part of criminal law and procedure. There is, therefore, no reason why representations giving rise to a review of a premises licence need be delayed pending the outcome of any criminal proceedings.

And finally Paragraph 11.26 states Where the licensing authority is conducting a review on the grounds that the premises have been used for criminal purposes, its role is solely to determine what steps should be taken in connection with the premises licence for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

On the 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017 Officers from Leicestershire Police attended the premises following information that stolen items were being bought and sold from the premises.

On entering Officers have spoke with Mr Kapil VAGHELIA who was the member of staff working in the shop.

Further items including perfume/after shave and more electrical items were recovered from behind the till/counter area.
