

I understand that the police have applied to revoke the licence at these premises.

I wish to object to this application on the following grounds:

I have known Mr Vaghela since he took over the premises and in all that time I have never seen anything which would suggest stolen goods are being handled. Neither have I ever been offered anything to buy other than that which I have gone to purchase. I have never seen anything sold either which looked at all suspicious, i.e. not part of what is normally stocked in the shop and I use the shop almost every day.

Mr Vaghela is a person of good standing in the local community. Indeed he and his family have suffered violent attacks during attempted robberies from his shop.

I would have thought that if the police have evidence then they should prosecute for the alleged crime, not removal of his licence. This seems disproportionate in the circumstances even if they have strong suspicion would a warning not be more appropriate.

I hope my views will be taken into account by the licensing authority.
