- 4) Events Management Plan will continue to include (same as TEN event held last year 17<sup>th</sup> June 2016):
  - a. Local Business and Residents Communication – this will be extended to a larger radius of up to ½ mile.
  - b. Noise management will allow for monitoring at various locations in and around the venue to cover a spectrum of local buildings both residential and commercial.

  - d. Licence Holder will retain control of the sound system together with an able sound technician for the event.
