Report of the Director of Neighbourhood and Environmental Services

1. Purpose of Report

1.1. This report provides information for Members about an application made under the Licensing Act 2003, to assist them in determining the outcome of that application.


2. Determination to be made

- 2.1. Having considered the application and representations, Members must consider whether to
 - Reject the review application
 - Modify the conditions of the licence
 - Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence
 - Remove the designated premises supervisor
 - Suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months
 - Revoke the licence
- 2.2 Where Members take the decision to reject the review application, they are permitted to issue an informal warning to the licence holder and / or recommend improvement within a particular period of time.

3. Summary

3.1 This report outlines an application for a review of an existing premises licence for Fountain Public House and summarises the representations received. It also highlights the licensing objectives, the relevant parts of the guidance and regulations, and the pertinent sections of the Licensing Authority's Licensing Policy.

6. Review application

- 6.1 An application was received on 24th August 2017 from Leicestershire Police for a review of the existing premises licence for Fountain Public House. The application was made on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix B.
- 6.2 Leicestershire Police are concerned that there have been a number of incidences of stolen goods being sold on the premises.

7. Representations

- 7.1 Sixteen representations were received during the representation period in support of the premises. A copy of the representations is attached at Appendix C1-C13, C15, C16 and C17.
- 7.2 A representation was received on 1st September 2017 from Age UK. The representation relates to the prevention of public nuisance. They are concerned that they are subject to noise and smoke nuisance from customers at the Fountain. A copy of the representation is attached at Appendix C14.

8 Steps to Promote the Licensing Objectives

8.1 In arriving at its decision on the review application, the Licensing Authority's primary consideration must be the promotion of the licensing objectives.

9. Statutory Guidance
