### 98. Declaration of interests

### 100. Responses to questions from the last meeting

Councillor Porter raised concerns regarding the lack of Youth Facilities in Aylestone. A resident commented that they felt the Gilmorton facilities were inadequate and it was dangerous for young people to travel to them from Aylestone, particularly when nights were dark. The Chair felt the Committee should make a recommendation to Cabinet to look at improving Youth Facilities in Aylestone. He felt that this could be provided through the use of a S106 agreement.
