I wish to make a representation in connection with this application as I consider this proposal could be detrimental to the licensing objective of preventing public nuisance.

The Broadway is situated in a mixed use area with a number of residential properties in close proximity. Historically we have had issues with noise break out from the club and I am concerned that live or amplified music or voice could affect the local residents if windows and doors are left open.

If the new premises licence is granted I would recommend that the following conditions are attached

All external doors and windows shall be kept closed, other than for access and egress, in all rooms when events involving amplified/live music or speech are taking place.

Disposal of waste bottles into external receptacles where the noise will be audible to neighbouring properties must not occur between 22.00 and 09.00 hours Monday to Sunday.

Notices to be displayed located by the exit requesting that customers leave the premises quietly and with consideration to neighbours

I have attempted contacted the applicant regarding these conditions, however I have not been able to do so.

I will recommend refusal for this licence application as it stands
