Layby & Parking Space Projects

- Ongoing programme across the ward
- Prioritised in collaboration with Ward Councillors and Housing Department
- 13 schemes in Eyres Monsell since 2014
- Total spend £436k
- This year works at Packhorse Road and Queensferry Parade

School Run Parking (SRP) Update

- Prioritised School Run Parking programme to address traffic issues around 120 schools in Leicester City
- Programme runs to March 2019 and is part of the wider Parking Strategy initiative developed in 2016
- The improvement measures include hard (physical), enforcement and soft (behaviour change) measures
- 2019/20 - Rolleston Primary School, Holy Cross Catholic Primary School, Eyres Monsell Primary School, Tudor Grange Samworth Academy

- Over 50 Learn to Ride sessions

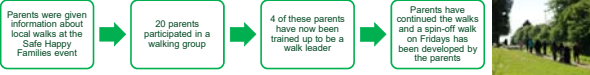
Bikeability

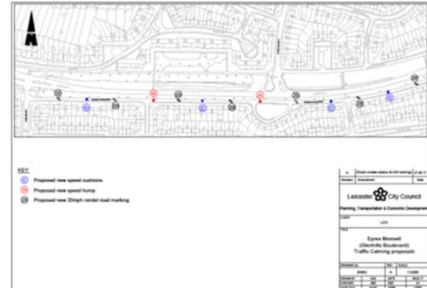
