# Appendix 1 - Traffic and Highways Actions

# Shady Lane / St Deny's Church -

- Development Plans previously agreed Update requested.
- Road resurfacing, uneven/ bumpy
- Potholes Not filled.

- Road signage re vehicle weight Obscured.
- Revision of the Island layout, outside church/ main problems re traffic.
- Re-think of the road to area following fatal / and critical RTA's.
- Overall Comment Not Fit for Purpose.

# Evington Road -

# (Evington Lane fork, leading to Evington Rd.)

- Traffic enforcement / parking both side of the road -hazard, obstructing emergency service/ frail elderly/ prams – via Evington Rd, and Whitehall Road.
- Investment in preventing speeding.

# Spencefield Lane -

- Traffic enforcement / parking both side of the road -hazard, obstructing emergency service/ frail elderly/ prams.
- Investment in preventing speeding.

# Downing Drive -

 School run – cars driving past the bollards, parking in front of houses preventing residents accessing property.

# Marydene Drive -

- No parking (yellow) lines obscured.
- Pencil bollards down to pavement prevents grass from being cut.
- Increase height of knee, high railings.

# Susan Avenue –

• Bollards recently installed – situated on crossing area, for people with special needs /obscuring safe access, cross the road.

# Mickleson Drive -

• Install Barriers / Humps prevent speeding.
