2.	<b>Councillors Feedback</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The meeting noted the rationale for the information fair, highlighting the priorities identified to support residents.</li><li>The format of the meeting was outlined to –<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Provide a brief overview of the service.</li><li>Encourage people to approach and network.</li></ul></li></ul>	
3.	<b>Play Zone – MUGA Ball Court</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Outline – Partnership with the football association to build nine multi play areas. One located in the Eyres Monsell area, currently developed and in full use.</li></ul>	
4.	<b>TCV – Green Gym Volunteers</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Outline – Located in the green at the rear of the Eyres Monsell community centre. A holistic growing project, aimed at raising awareness on mental health issues. Referrals taken via GP and community groups.</li></ul>	
5.	<b>Zinithiya Trust</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Outline – Charity organisation aimed at Women, families, and Children experiencing Domestic Abuse. The organisation assists with maximising income, debt management, and obtaining grants. The service includes a coffee shop, a low-cost ambient goods shop, and male Domestic Violence Signposting.</li></ul>	

6.	<b>Gold Hill Adventure Playground</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Outline – Remit provision extended to include a multifunction Alternative Provision School with 167 (SEND) places available. The Food Bank remains operational delivering forty parcels a week, plus the market. The development of the Mental Health Group, now operate a Food Bank from the Gilmorton Rooms.</li> </ul>		
7.	<b>Ward Community Budget</b>	
<p>The meeting noted a Ward Funding update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ward Funding April 2024 – March 2025 - £18,000.</li> <li>Number of applications supported to date: 10.</li> <li>Spent: £8,750.</li> <li>Balance remaining: £9,250.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Outline – Independent body, patients’ champions - on NHS experiences locally. NHS funded service, ‘watchdog’ / highlighting the voice of users, in social care, hospital discharges. Announcement of a Women’s Health.</li> </ul>
