3.	OPTIONS FOR LOCATIONS FOR BENCHES	<p>Three options presented with initial feedback. Option for the site adjacent to the Telephone Exchange identified as the preference by show of hands.</p> <p>Suggested Media opportunity once installed noted.</p>

DEMENTIA AWARENESS	<p>Local Doctor was invited to inform the meeting of ongoing work to combat memory loss.</p> <p>The symptoms and effects of dementia were explained, and the links to the work of the Alzheimer's Society were noted.</p> <p>Guidance was provided on how to keep active to prevent dementia.</p>
5.	PATCHWALK FEEDBACK	<p>Councillors, Warden, other Officers and Police attended patchwalk with community reps and interested parties. Identified issues and suggestions:</p> <p>Cedar Road Play Area</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Levelling of ball court surface • CCTV installation to prevent ASB • Signage refurbishment, ask children to design • Residents adj. may require higher fencing • New lighting required to improve security <p>Onslow Street Gardens</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not considered to be child friendly • Options for alternative use to be looked at in

POLICE	<p>Ben Gillard referred to his recent appointment as Inspector.</p> <p>Evington Road causing some concern, ASB related</p> <p>Bogus charity collectors being dealt with, joint working with the Council officers.</p> <p>Parking issues being dealt with, reports received concerning schools increasing</p> <p>Kasabian concert planning ongoing.</p> <p>ASB problems reduced with closure of Upper Titchbourne Hostel.</p> <p>PS Danny Graham seconded to Mansfield House. A replacement Sergeant to be appointed.</p> <p>Neighbourhood Liaison meetings continuing, proving to be very useful.</p>

KASABIAN CONCERT	<p>Highways and event planning implications presented.</p> <p>Date confirmed as 21 June, original application to Licensing was for two dates.</p> <p>Times confirmed as 9 pm – 11 pm (opening at 3.00 pm)</p> <p>Significant multi agency work ongoing.</p> <p>Residents parking implications and enforcement clarified.</p> <p>One way gyratory system around Victoria Park described to aid traffic flow.</p>
