33. APPEAL AGAINST DISMISSAL

The Committee was requested to consider an appeal against dismissal from employment with the City Council under the Council's disciplinary policy. Karen Demmer (HR Team Manager) and Ruth Tennant (Director of Public Health) were present as advisors to the Committee.
