### Report of the Director of Neighbourhood and Environmental Services

### 1. Purpose of Report

1.1. This report provides information for Members about an objection notice received in relation to a temporary event notice (TEN) given under the Licensing Act 2003, to assist them in determining the outcome.

#### 2. Determination to be made

- 2.1. Having considered the temporary event notice and the objection notice, Members must consider whether to
  - Give the premises user a counter notice under Section 105 (2) of the Licensing Act 2003 if it is considered appropriate for the promotion of a licensing objective to do so; or
  - Impose one or more conditions on the temporary event notice if:
    - o it is appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives to do so, and
    - the condition(s) are also imposed on a premises licence or club premises certificate that has effect in relation to all or part of the same premises as the temporary, and
    - the condition(s) would not be inconsistent with the carrying out of the licensable activities under the temporary event notice; or
  - Disregard the objection notice

### 3. Summary

3.1 This report outlines an objection notice given by the Police in response to temporary event notices given by Mr Prabdeep Pabla for Mamba, 29 Market Street, Leicester. It also highlights the licensing objectives, the relevant parts of the guidance and regulations, and the pertinent sections of the Licensing Authority's Licensing Policy.

- 5.1. A temporary event notice was given on 24 November 2019 by Mr Pabla for an event at Mamba. The temporary event notice is for an event on 10-11 December 2019 and is attached at Appendix A.
- 5.2. A temporary event notice was given on 24 November 2019 by Mr Pabla for an event at Mamba. The temporary event notice is for an event on 31 December 2019 into 1 January 2020 and is attached at Appendix B.

### 7. Existing premises licence

7.1 The premises identified in the temporary event notice is fully covered by an existing premises licence. One or more of the conditions on this premises licence may be applied to the temporary event notice if Members consider it appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives, and insofar as the conditions are not inconsistent with the carrying on of licensable activities under the notice. A copy of the existing premises licence, including the conditions are attached at Appendix D.

provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective; b)

provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

- these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
