Subject: Revolution Bars Limited, New Walk

I understand that Revolution Bars Limited has applied to vary their Premises Licence and I wish to OBJECT.

As a Resident of New Walk I wish to object to the extension/changes proposed on the grounds that they are likely to cause increased **Public Nuisance**(noise control) and **Crime & Disorder** (cycling on New Walk)

The proposed delivery service between 11pm and 3 am, on a daily basis, is particularly irritating - a delivery service indicates that it's door to door but the only vehicle that should be used on New Walk is "Shanks's Pony" *(see below) not cycles and definitely not motorised bikes which are already on the increase - I can't see anyone parking on Wellington Street/King Street and collecting deliveries or walking their bikes on New Walk!

The increase in noise in this residential area is already often at a barely tolerable level and the proposed delivery service is certain to exacerbate the nuisance this causes to residents.

Are lives are being blighted by drinkers and delivery companies (Deliveroo, UberEats, etc) using New Walk as a quick conduit for deliveries and Revolution and other similar establishments operate without consideration for the location or its residents.
