EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Our Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy sets out the health priorities for Leicester and provides details of the Health and Wellbeing Board's plans over the next five years. It has been developed and informed from a variety of sources, including, engagement workshops, consideration of other strategies and plans and an 8 week public consultation.
