Licensing Act 2003 - New Application. Application Ref: 123242 Prevention of Public Nuisance. Curry Flavour Restaurant and Bar, 225 Uppingham Road

I wish to make a representation in connection with this application as I consider this proposal will be detrimental to the licensing objective of preventing public nuisance.

The proposed restaurant/bar is situated on Uppingham Road in a mixed use area within the city that is fairly busy with traffic and other on street noise. This on-street noise drops of as it gets to night time and by midnight almost all the other commercial buildings are closed, and the traffic has died right down resulting in a much lower background noise level.

I am concerned that if this restaurant/bar is allowed to open until 02.00 hours the noise from the associated on-street noise (people smoking outside the front of the premises, cars taxis coming and going, people talking, laughing etc as they leave the venue) is likely to cause a nuisance to residential properties opposite.

Therefore, I would recommend that if the premises licence is granted that the hours are changed, and the following conditions are attached in the interests of preventing public nuisance

Premises Opening Hours

Sunday to Thursday 11.00- 23.00 hours Friday to Saturday 11.00- 00.30 hours

Supply of Alcohol

Sunday to Thursday 11.00- 22.30 hours Friday to Saturday 11.00- 00.00 hours

Late Night Refreshment

Friday to Saturday 11.00- 00.30 hours

All external doors and windows shall be kept closed, other than for access and egress, in all rooms when events involving amplified/live music or speech are taking place.

\*(Note to applicant this may mean that air conditioning is required)

Notices to be displayed, located by the exit, requesting that customers leave the premises quietly and with consideration to neighbours.

I have contacted the applicant regarding these conditions and that if they are acceptable, I have requested that they contact you in writing regarding this to confirm their agreement.

In the absence of such a formal written request being made, I will recommend refusal for this licence application as it stands
