I am writing to object to the granting of a license for Piggy's burger van opposite 153, Scudamore road Leicester, LE3 1UQ.

The reasons for objection are as follows.

- 1, There is an established burger van outside 153 already which can cause traffic problems now (we are no way connected to this business)
- 2, It is close to the corner of Wembley Road which with all the extra traffic created by Samworth brothers Artics has become a difficult junction to navigate with many near misses daily a burger van parked there will only exacerbate this problem by blocking vision for drivers exiting Wembley Road which is a very busy main junction on the trading estate..
- 3, There is no road parking during the day for customers as it is all taken early in the morning and people park on the pavement now at times, every business on Scudamore road have existing problems with customer and visitor parking and some with staff parking.
- 4, We have Artics in and out all day for two companies on the site of 153 and sometimes even now they cannot get in due to vehicles parked opposite and sometimes on the yellow lines.
- 5, We are a HGV driver training company and have DVSA examiners starting test from our premises, if their exit from our car park is impaired by parked cars they could fail their test having paid for training and a test fee.
- 6, Finally the estate is already well served with burger vans/cafe (4) plus a mobile van that comes round daily.
