Confirmation Hearing to consider a candidate for the post of Chief Executive to the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner – 2nd December 2021

Record of recommendation of the Panel to the Police and Crime Commissioner

The Police and Crime Panel held a special meeting on Thursday 2nd December at 2.30pm at County Hall, Leicestershire to consider the proposed appointment of a candidate, Mr David Peet, to the post of Chief Executive.

The Panel considered Mr Peet's candidacy in line with the recommended Local Government Association Guidance, and followed the following process:

- a. The candidate was welcomed to the meeting.
- b. The Commissioner presented to the Panel on the candidate and the proposed appointment.
- c. The candidate presented to the Panel their understanding of the role.
- d. The Panel asked questions of the candidate.
- e. The candidate clarified to clarify any answers given during the hearing and ask questions of the Panel about the next stage of the process.


Recommendation and publication:
