

**EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT****PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE – GWENDOLEN ROAD AREA**  
**STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS**

- D.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- D.2 1584 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the proposed 20mph Zone for the Gwendolen Road Area. 255 replies were received which represents a 16% response rate.

215 (84%) were in favour of the 20mph speed limit and 37 (15%) were against. There were also 3 (1%) 'Don't know' responses. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph speed limit.

194 (76%) were in favour of the proposed traffic calming measures and 50 (20%) were against. There were also 8 (3%) 'Don't know' responses and 3 (1%) left blank. This shows there is also considerable public support for the traffic calming proposals for the area.

- D.3 In addition, 37 responses from outside the consultation area were received through consultation on the City Council's website. Of these, 24 (65%) were in favour of both the 20mph speed limit and the traffic calming with 12 (32%) against the 20mph speed limit and 11 (30%) against the traffic calming.

A detailed breakdown of responses is shown as Appendix E.

- D.4 Several associated issues have been raised through the consultation process. Where these have been raised by three or more respondents, the issues are summarised below:-

- D.5 **Make some streets one-way**

Five respondents commented that they would like to see additional one-way streets in the area, three requests relate to Dorothy Road whilst two relate to the Osborne Road area.

These can be added to the list of one-way requests across the city. They can then be assessed and prioritised against other similar requests for the limited funding available for such work.
