Fly-Tipping

Fly Tipping is a consistent issue in the area. I am currently carrying out investigations in to this fly tip on Heard Walk. Evidence was obtained so further action will be taken.

Untidy Gardens

I have had several reports of untidy/overgrown gardens. This front garden on Portmore Close is currently under a notice to clear the waste and cut back the overgrowth.

Vehicles for sale/repairs

I have been monitoring Stokes Drive, Benskins Oval & Calder Road after receiving reports of cars sales and repairs being carried out on the public highway. To date I have seen no activity of this but please if you do witness this taking place you can report to us along with a witness statement and any footage that you have of this occurring and this can be looked in to further.









How does it work?

- 1.Download it Our free app is available for Android, Windows, Blackberry and iPhones. Simply visit your app store and search for Love Leicester.
- 2.Spot it Whether it's graffiti, litter, fly-tipping, dog fouling or another environmental problem, you can let us know about it.
- 3.Report it Take a picture of the problem and upload it using the app. You can tag the location and include other details so we can fix the issue quickly.
- 4.Fix it When you submit your report the details and picture will be sent to the right team who can fix the problem. They'll also be able to post a picture of what they've done.
