

EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT**PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE – BRAUNSTONE COMMUNITY PRIMARY SCHOOL**
STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS

- E.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- E.2 896 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the proposed 20mph Zone for Braunstone Community Primary School. 108 replies were received which represents a 12% response rate.

98 (91%) were in favour of the 20mph speed limit and 8 (7%) were against. There were also 2 (2%) 'Don't know' responses. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph speed limit.

93 (86%) were in favour of the proposed traffic calming measures and 10 (9%) were against. There were also 5 (5%) 'Don't know' responses. This shows there is also considerable public support for the traffic calming proposals for the area.

- E.3 In addition, 2 responses from outside the consultation area were received through consultation on the City Council's website. These were both in favour of the 20mph speed limit and the traffic calming proposals.
