Beaumont Leys Ward Action Plan 2008-09 The Priorities for Beaumont Leys Ward

This is our ward community plan for 2008-10. It describes the three priorities that the ward community meeting has decided it wants to achieve by 31st March 2010. These priorities were agreed at the ward community meeting on 10th December 2008. If we achieve these priorities we will know that Beaumont Leys Ward Community Meeting has been successful in 2008-09.

This may not seem like many priorities. But by choosing a small number we will make sure we concentrate our work on the things we know are important and achievable. If we do achieve them before the end of the year – or we find we can't achieve them – we will chose further priorities through discussion with local people.

In some cases, the priority will not be able to be completely solved in one year. If so, the Ward Action Plan should say what it aims to do **towards** solving the problem by the end of the year, in a way that measures that progress.

Throughout the year council officers will monitor whether the agreed action is taking place. At the end of the year the ward meeting will be given an annual report on all of the priorities agreed and whether the action has taken place and been successful. This will help the ward meeting plan its priorities for the following year.

Not enough provision for children and young people, often resulting in anti social behaviour.

26% of residents are under 16 compared to city average of 22%

How do we know it's a problem?

The issue was mentioned by 40 respondents i.e. 51%

Reflected in the Mori Residents Satisfaction Survey 2005

The issue is a priority in the Neighbourhood Area Plan

What action will be taken by March 2009?

An audit of provision to include voluntary provision will be carried out.

Current providers will be asked to present their plans for the next year

A young peoples sub group will be set up to monitor the coordination and delivery of provision across the ward Young people to be present on the sub group. Make links to the B.Leys Youth JAG Mapping Plan

Support for youth based community events.

Consider how effectively young people are sign posted to existing provision

Level of support for youth based community events through Ward grants.

Whether there is an increase in youth provision.
