

**Hearsay Evidence:** The complainant must submit enough information which, if proven, would show that the subject member has acted in breach of the Code at the time of the alleged misconduct. Although it is not for the Assessment/Review Sub-Committees to investigate or to weigh up evidence/reject evidence, even hearsay evidence, sufficient tangible facts must be presented for assessment to enable a decision to be made that a complaint should be referred to investigation or other action.
