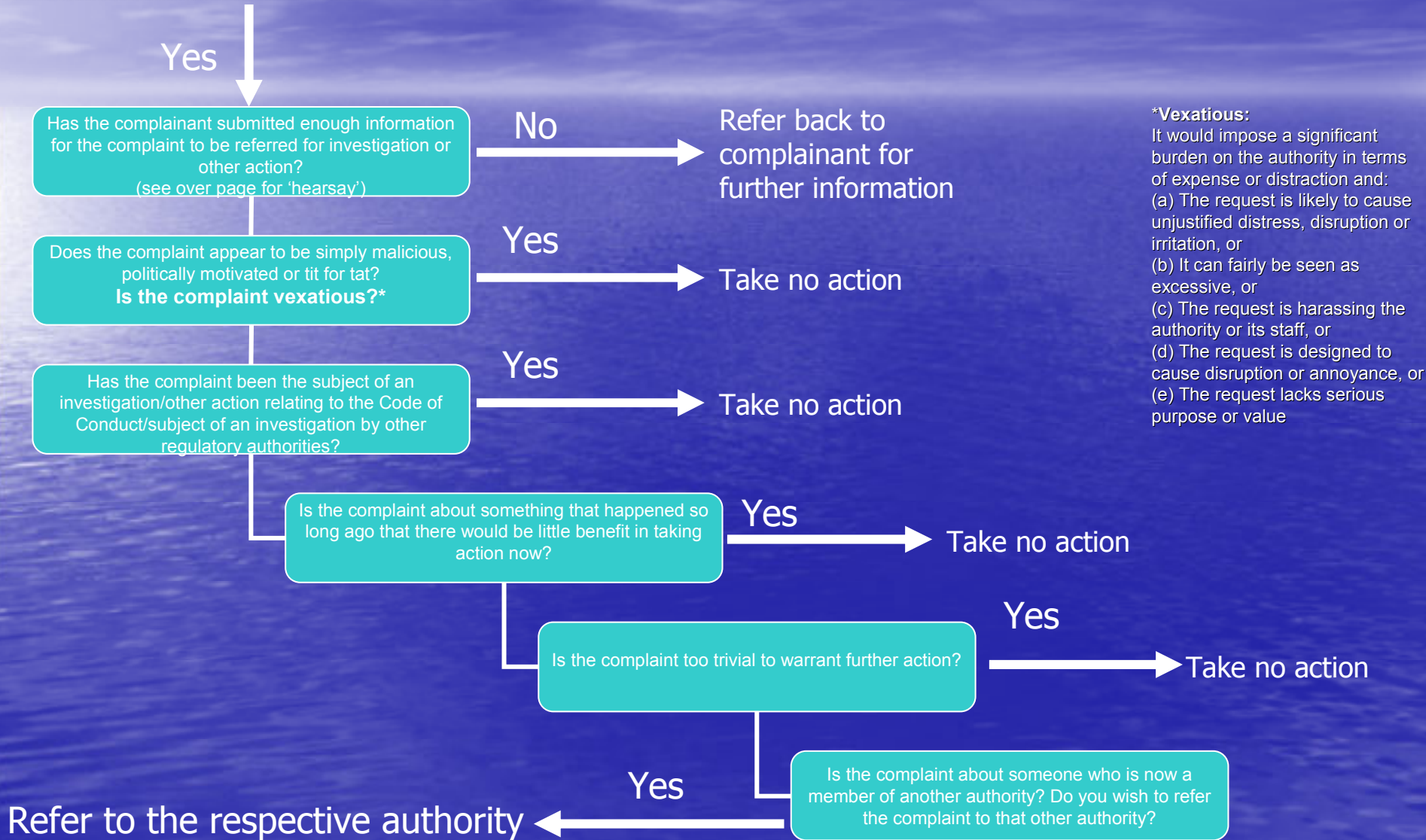


Standards Initial Assessment Sub-Committee

1. Is the complaint against one or more named members of the authority covered by the standards committee?
2. Was the named member in office at the time of the alleged conduct, and the Code of Conduct in force?
3. If proven, would the complaint be a breach of the Code of Conduct under which the members was operating at the time of the misconduct?



Hearsay Evidence: *The complainant must submit enough information which, if proven, would show that the subject member has acted in breach of the Code at the time of the alleged misconduct. Although it is not for the Assessment/Review Sub-Committees to investigate or to weigh up evidence/reject evidence, even hearsay evidence, sufficient tangible facts must be presented for assessment to enable a decision to be made that a complaint should be referred to investigation or other action.*

If proven: Would the complaint constitute a breach of the Code of Conduct?
If so, what section(s) of the Code?
