Please summarise your concerns about this application:

I am concerned about potential noise nuisance from these premises from the operation of audio visual equipment affecting the adjoining house 39 Howard Road which shares a party wall with Salvador Deli, 50 Queens Road.

The Noise Team has received a noise complaint from the occupier of 39 Howard Road, and we are waiting for further details from the complainant before investigating this matter further.

Whilst the applicant has indicated that the audio visual equipment will be used to advertise products for sale in the shop the licence if granted would not restrict the equipment to just this use.

So to reduce the risk of any nuisance I have agreed a condition with the applicant to be attached to the premises licence:

CONDITION

Any plasma screens/audio equipment affixed to the party wall between the premises and (insert address) or sited within 2 metres of that wall shall not be used to provide any audio entertainment.

Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives

The introduction of audio visual equipment into these premises increases the risk Of noise nuisance being caused to residential occupiers of 39 Howard Road, which share a party wall.

Noise transmission through the party wall (particularly lower frequency noise) would be increased if audio visual equipment is attached to this wall as the fixings will penetrate the party wall and the noise source will be close to the party wall. The proposed condition should deal with these issues.
