<p>This existing takeaway food outlet is situated on the corner of Granby Street and Belvoir Street. The area is a mixed use of bars, restaurants, food outlets, retail, commercial and some residential. The area is normally busy throughout the day and into the early hours of the morning.</p> <p>There are 7 flats adjoining the premise on Belvoir Street, a further 15 flats opposite at Wellington Court on Granby Street and 7 Flats nearby at 48 Granby Street.</p> <p>I am concerned that allowing the business to operate such long hours will increase the likelihood of noise complaints and cause disturbance to residents by customers visiting the premises throughout the night and particularly into the early hours of the morning. There is also the likelihood of noise disturbance from deliveries and staff activities.</p>
