Please summarise your concerns about this application:
I have concerns that noisy processes within the premises, as well as off the premises, may transmit to and intrude on neighbouring properties. The application includes dance and alcohol, which could both contribute to increased noise levels at this premises.

Please give further details of why you believe this application will have an adverse effect on the licensing objectives

This application for a premises licence for dance and alcohol is in a mixed residential and commercial area. Dance in various forms can produce noise that could break out of the premises and cause nuisance to neighbours, particularly up until 04:00am (Monday - Sunday), as requested with this application.

People using the pavement at the front of the premises for smoking/vaping may be a cause of noise nuisance, and this could lead to the entrance door being left open which will allow noise to transmit out of the premises, exacerbated if there is no lobby. It is also unclear to what extent the current insulation and glazing will attenuate air borne or structure borne noise.

If premises is permitted to open until 04:00am, the ambient noise level will likely be increased from activity on and off the premises causing disturbance to nearby residences. This will particularly be an issue from Sunday to Thursday where activity in the area is at a reduced level, due to other nearby licensed premises having an earlier closing time.

I may be able to agree conditions with the applicant that would satisfy my concerns. However, for the time being I recommend that the application be refused.
