We wish to raise an objection to the recent licence application for the premises at the address above.

In our opinion, allowing another venue in this neighbourhood to sell alcohol up to 4am each morning will not contribute positively to the licensing objectives regarding the prevention of Public Nuisance and Crime and Disorder and is likely to cause increased noise and disturbance to people living nearby.

Premises nearby (8-10 King Street) have a late night/early morning licence and are well-known to the Police as a site of crime, disorder and public nuisance. Enabling a venue in close proximity to sell alcohol in the early hours will surely only add to these problems.
