She also suggested that this area could be used as an outdoor classroom, prior to going into the Spinney. Queensmead school recently held a science lesson in the Spinney and the children, were very well behaved and enthusiastic and our group thoroughly enjoyed their visit.

the Spinney which should result in less anti social behaviour.
