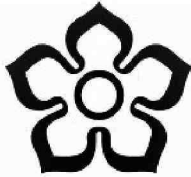

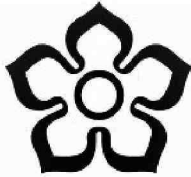

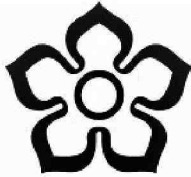

## ANNEXES

### Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises-

- a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
  - i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supplied alcohol), or
  - ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
- e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either-

- a) a holographic mark, or
- b) an ultraviolet feature.

The responsible person shall ensure that-

- a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-
  - i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
  - ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
  - iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;
- b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

### Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

The restrictions in this Annex do not prohibit any sale, supply or consumption of alcohol previously permitted by the Licensing Act 1964.

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied unless it is paid for before or at the time when it is sold or supplied, except alcohol sold or supplied with and for consumption at a meal supplied at the same time, consumed with the meal and paid for together with the meal.

No person under fourteen shall be in the bar of the licensed premises during the hours that the premises is licensed for the sale of alcohol, except as

previously permitted by the Licensing Act 1964.

Licensable activities may continue between the end of the hours permitted by the licence on New Years Eve and the start of the hours permitted by the licence on New Years Day.

The licence is subject to Leicester City Council's Standard Conditions for Places of Public Entertainment, published on the Licensing Authority's website [www.leicester.gov.uk/licensing](http://www.leicester.gov.uk/licensing)

The maximum permitted number(s) of persons allowed when regulated entertainment is taking place is (are) as follows:

Ground Floor 120 persons  
First Floor 110 persons  
Second Floor 110 persons  
Third Floor 110 persons

The occupancy to include ALL persons employed within the premises and ALL persons resorting to the premises.

The premises are structurally adapted and bona fide/intended to be used for the purpose of providing for persons resorting to the premises music and dancing and substantial refreshment to which the sale of intoxicating liquor is ancillary.

There shall be no change in the concept of the premises as presented to the Committee on 3rd September 1998.

There shall be the provision of CCTV in the premises installed in conjunction with liaison with the Police. Such cameras to be of a video recording nature.

The licence holder shall maintain records of door staff and supply a copy of such record to the Chief Constable c/o Chief Superintendent, Leicestershire Constabulary, Mansfield House, 74 Belgrave Gate, Leicester, LE1 3GG.

Substantial food shall be available during all opening hours.

Waiter/waitress service shall be available at all times for service of food.

There shall be no amusement machines whether Section 34 Gaming machines or otherwise on the premises.

On the Ground and first Floor there shall be seating facilities available at all times for 50% of the agreed occupancy figure.

The maximum occupancy figure for the premises shall be determined by the appropriate authority and noted upon the Licensing Register.

The licence holder shall train staff in its policy requiring the production of "proof of age" for any sale that takes place where there is any suspicion that the customer is under 25.

The licence holder shall ensure licensed taxi company information is available to customers on leaving the premises.

The licence holder shall ensure no customers are served who appear to be intoxicated.

The licence holder shall ensure internal windows and doors are kept closed.

The licence holder shall ensure the dance floor has soundproofing installed.

The licence holder shall operate a policy of last entry times and decrease DJ sounds.

**Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the Licensing Authority**

Alteration to licensable activities hours on 15.06.2006

Variation to licensable activities/standard timings on 14/3/13 - additional conditions:

The licence holder will ensure music is played at a lower level on Friday & Saturday nights 30 minutes before the close of premises.

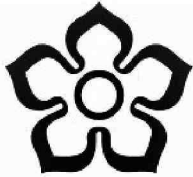

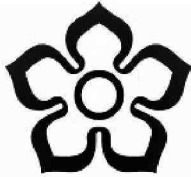

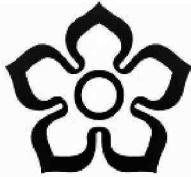
