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> The area already suffers from regular late night street drinking around shops selling alcohol late at night.

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> Alcohol related incidents around shops like One Stop are a reality, and another shop further along Evington Rd will introduce the same issues where they currently don't exist and create the potential for alcohol related violence and disturbances. We already have other issues related to operating hours, shops and businesses seem to be open way beyond licensing hours, this has caused unrest, shooting, stabbing and general public disorder, intimidation and violence.

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> Operating till midnight in a residential area will create additional noise with cars parking in residential streets as there is insufficient parking around the premises already. This seems more burden to an area an community under severe parking already.
