6.	Reason for decision	The TMBs at Judgemeanow Community College are no longer required to support additional places at the school. These units will be relocated to other educational sites to support mainstream and specialist places. This decision relates to the installation of TMB units at St John the Baptist Primary School to create bulge classes in year 5 and year 6 and suitable classroom for pupils at Glebelands Primary School. This ensures suitable and sufficient places in the city.
