Appendix A - Indicative Project List

The below projects currently represent the proposed projects to be delivered using funding delivered under the Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP) grant. These projects are subject to change during design, consultation, and delivery.

Stream one - Electric Bus Investment

Delivery of a locally run subsidy scheme that emulates the national ZEBRA scheme, allowing for up to 60 electric buses to be purchased and integrated into the Leicester bus fleet.

Stream two - Local Service Support

Ongoing support for bus services across the city, including but not limited to:

- Park and Ride (103, 203, and 303)
- Orbital
- Hop!
- 13
- 21
- 74
- Hospital Hopper

The nature of support will vary depending on the service – for some this will be full operational costs, for others it will be contribution towards overheads, or it may be funding uplifts such as later running, higher frequency, or weekend/Sunday operation.

Stream three - Real Time Information

Costs associated with the maintenance and expansion of the city's Real Time Information network.

Stream four - Branding and Integration

Further work to provide more integrated bus services – targeted marketing and branding exercises to aid public access; printed timetable information at select stops within and outside of the city centre to trial unified information and branding.
