

EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT**PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT – ST JOSEPHS & NETHERHALL**
STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS

- D.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- D.2 1952 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the proposed 20mph Speed Limit for the St Josephs & Netherhall Area. 303 replies were received which represents a 16% response rate.

246 (81%) were in favour of the 20mph Speed Limit and 55 (18%) were against. 2 (1%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the speed reduction. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph Speed Limit.

224 (74%) were in favour of the traffic calming and 72 (24%) were against. 7 (2%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the traffic calming. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the traffic calming.

- D.3 There was 1 response from outside the consultation area received through consultation on the City Council's website.

A detailed breakdown of responses is shown as Appendix D.

- D.4 Issues raised during the Consultation Process

5 residents requested that extra traffic calming be added on Wigley Road to make the entire road traffic calmed, as well as providing extra protection to the junction with Cardinals Walk.

Councillor Bonham also requested this.
