EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT

PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT – ST JOSEPHS & NETHERHALL STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS

D.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- D.2 1952 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the proposed 20mph Speed Limit for the St Josephs & Netherhall Area. 303 replies were received which represents a 16% response rate.
 - 246 (81%) were in favour of the 20mph Speed Limit and 55 (18%) were against. 2 (1%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the speed reduction. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph Speed Limit.
 - 224 (74%) were in favour of the traffic calming and 72 (24%) were against. 7 (2%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the traffic calming. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the traffic calming.
- D.3 There was 1 response from outside the consultation area received through consultation on the City Council's website.
 - A detailed breakdown of responses is shown as Appendix D.
- D.4 Issues raised during the Consultation Process
 - 5 residents requested that extra traffic calming be added on Wigley Road to make the entire road traffic calmed, as well as providing extra protection to the junction with Cardinals Walk.
 - Councillor Bonham also requested this.
