

**EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT****PROPOSED 20MPH ZONE – BRAUNSTONE SOUTH**  
**STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS**

- F.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- F.2 1610 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the Braunstone South Area. 214 replies were received which represents a 13% response rate.

164 (77%) were in favour of the 20mph Speed Limit reduction and 43 (20%) were against. 7 (3%) were either unsure on the speed reduction or had no opinion. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph Speed Limit.

151 (71%) were in favour of the traffic calming and 51 (24%) were against. 12 (6%) were either unsure on the speed reduction or had no opinion. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the traffic calming.

- F.3 There was 1 response from outside the consultation area received.

- F.4 Issues raised during the Consultation Process

Several requests were made to include extra traffic calming on various roads through the estate.

It is considered that due to the existing level of public support, it would be prudent to continue with the current proposals and undertake after surveys to help ascertain if further measures are warranted.
