

**EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT****PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT – AYLESTONE PARK**  
**STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS**

- D.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- D.2 2079 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the proposed 20mph Speed Limit for the Aylestone Park Area. 224 replies were received which represents an 11% response rate.

181 (81%) were in favour of the 20mph Speed Limit and 40 (18%) were against. 3 (1%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the speed reduction. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph Speed Limit.

143 (64%) were in favour of the traffic calming and 69 (31%) were against. 12 (5%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the traffic calming. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the traffic calming.

- D.3 There was 1 response from outside the consultation area received through consultation on the City Council's website.

A detailed breakdown of responses is shown as Appendix E.

- D.4 Issues raised during the Consultation Process

A number of residents requested that traffic calming was installed on several other roads in the area, including.

- Cavendish Road
- Grace Road
- Hugenden Drive
- Lansdowne Road
- Lothair Road
- Percy Road
- Richmond Road
- Vernon Road

Due to the lower recorded speeds on these roads, it is suggested to survey them again during post scheme monitoring, with no further traffic calming proposed at this time. There are also other works scheduled around the area over the next few months, which may reduce speeds further.
