The playing surface was resurfaced a couple of years ago and the new fence would complete this popular and well used facility.

The fence is deteriating weekly and would be very costly to repair so it was felt that it would be more cost effective that it would be replaced with an all steel weldmesh type fencing (The same fencing at tennis courts at Knighton Park and Monks Rest Gardens).
