

EXECUTIVE DECISION REPORT

PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT – BRAUNSTONE EAST **STAGE 2 CONSULTATIONS**

- D.1 The outcomes from the Stage 2 Consultation, together with responses as appropriate, are shown below.

- D.2 1580 letters, plans and response forms were delivered to all properties within the proposed 20mph Speed Limit for the Mellor Area. 179 replies were received which represents a 11% response rate.
- 131 (77%) were in favour of the 20mph Speed Limit and 46 (26%) were against. 2 (1%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the speed reduction. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the 20mph Speed Limit.
- 122 (68%) were in favour of the traffic calming and 54 (30%) were against. 3 (2%) were either unsure or had no opinion on the traffic calming. This shows considerable public support for the introduction of the traffic calming.
- D.3 There were 0 responses from outside the consultation area received through consultation on the City Council's website.

- Councillor Barton asked that Overpark Avenue be investigated for the addition of traffic calming.
