I live behind the restaurant where the new ground floor extension is and have already witnessed the public nuisance it causes.

Although I have double glazing installed I was still able to hear the music. The back of the restaurant is also then used by the customers as a smoking area which again causes a lot of noise. During the time the restaurant was in breach of the original licence when having karaoke evenings I asked from my window for the smokers to refrain from using the area only to be verbally abused. These smokers were also consuming alcohol outside the restaurant. Also the customers are allowed to park in the alley way which may contravene safety rules.
