- Repeater signs

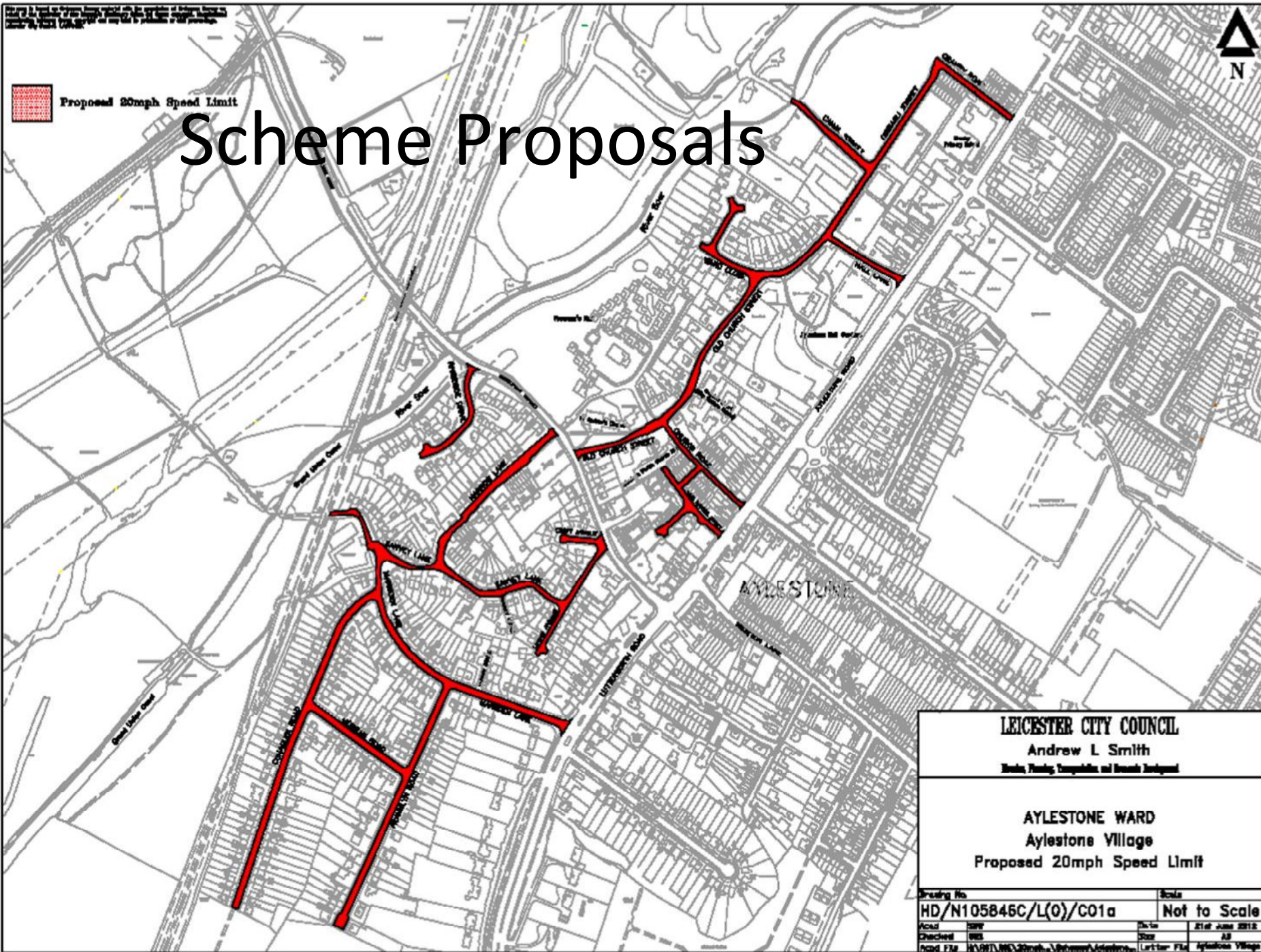
- New DfT relaxations blur the distinction
