I write in my capacity as Licensing Officer for Leicestershire Police on the authority delegated to me by the Chief Officer of Police.
Please take notice that I am satisfied that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine the Crime & Disorder Prevention and Public Safety
We would like to submit our representations for this premises application based upon the above stated licensing objectives.
The premises is situated on a specific route near the night time economy area which leads out to a hotel that is used by many travelling into the city for the night and a late night casino.

It is in our opinion that allowing the hours asked for will encourage people to attend the premises after drinking in the centre and have more alcohol prior to their end destination.

The premises is identified in the application as a restaurant and would suggest that an opening until 05:00hrs would undermine this.

We believe that adding the below conditions along with those attached to the operating schedule will assist in upholding the licensing objectives stated:

- 1) The licence holder will employ SIA registered security to deal with any likely contingency
- 2) The licence holder will ensure that CCTV is installed following advice from the Leicestershire Police, recording during all hours licensable activities are allowed and maintained in accordance with the Information Commissioner's CCTV Code of Practice.
- 3) CCTV will be kept for a minimum of 28 days and made available upon request to responsible authorities.
- 4) No person under 18 will be allowed on the premises without being accompanied by an adult
- 5) The premises licence holder will adopt the Challenge 21 policy and provide full training to the staff which will be repeated every 3 months
- 6) All licensable activities will cease at 01:00hrs and the opening hours will be until 01:30hrs
