#### **Report of the Director of Environmental Services**

#### 1. Purpose of Report

1.1. This report provides information for Members about an application made under the Licensing Act 2003, to assist them in determining the outcome of that application.


#### 2. Determination to be made

- 2.1. Having considered the application, Members must consider whether to
  - Reject the review application
  - Modify the conditions of the licence
  - Exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence
  - Remove the designated premises supervisor
  - Suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months
  - Revoke the licence
- 2.2 Where Members take the decision to reject the review application, they are permitted to issue an informal warning to the licence holder and / or recommend improvement within a particular period of time.

#### 3. Summary

3.1 This report outlines an application for a review of an existing premises licence for F Bar and summarises the representation(s) received. It also highlights the licensing objectives, the relevant parts of the guidance and regulations, and the pertinent sections of the Licensing Authority's Licensing Policy.

#### 6. Review application

- 6.1 An application was received on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2014 from Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service for a review of the existing premises licence for F Bar. The application was made on the grounds of public safety. A copy of the application is attached at Appendix B.
- 6.2 Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service are concerned that the applicant has failed to provide evidence of compliance with fire safety legislation and has failed to respond to the fire service when required

### 7. Steps to Promote the Licensing Objectives

7.1 In arriving at its decision on the review application, the Licensing Authority's primary consideration must be the promotion of the licensing objectives.
