I wish to make representation in connection with this application for a temporary event notice (TEN) as I consider this proposal will be detrimental to the licensing objective of public nuisance.

There is a flat directly opposite the premises as well as on Berridge Street a short distance away. I am satisfied that if the existing licence conditions relating to the prevention of a noise nuisance are not applied, then it is likely that a noise nuisance will occur.

I recommend that:

The following conditions that are already present on Premises Licence LEIPRM0905 are added to the TEN in the interests of preventing public nuisance from noise emanating from the premises:

1. A noise limiting device shall be installed, fitted and maintained in such a manner as to control all sources of amplified music and voice at the premises. The level shall be set to the agreement of the Noise Control Team to prevent noise nuisance being caused to the public. Once the device is set it should be inaccessible to the licence holder and their staff."
2. The licence holder will ensure that the door leading onto Market Place South is only used as disabled access when there is no regulated entertainment taking place on the premises, so as to prevent noise break out. This door shall also be used as a fire exit in all circumstances".

I will make every effort to contact the applicant. If an agreement is reached, I have requested that they contact you in writing. In the absence of such a formal written request being made, I will recommend refusal for this TEN application as it stands.
