## PARISH AUDIT REPORT - WHAT IS IT? (1)

- It's the result of detailed research into the facts and figures about the Braunstone community
- It's taken from the 2011 Census, and other sources

### PARISH AUDIT REPORT - WHAT IS IT? (2)

- \* It includes interviews with key workers
- \* It also includes observation walks, over every street in the parish
- It follows a similar audit, done 10 years ago

## PARISH AUDIT REPORT - HEADLINES (1)

- Braunstone is younger than the city average (which is younger than the national average)
- Braunstone is less white than 10 years ago (from over 90% to under 75%)

# PARISH AUDIT REPORT - HEADLINES (2)

- Braunstone is still educationally deprived, but its schools have made spectacular progress in the last 10 years
- Braunstone's health has also improved in the last 10 years

## PARISH AUDIT REPORT - HEADLINES (3)

Braunstone has areas of high % of single parents and young children, and different areas with high % of elderly people: these areas have different but important needs

## PARISH AUDIT REPORT - HEADLINES (4)

- Braunstone has low % of car ownership, which makes public transport more than usually important
- \* Braunstone has areas of high unemployment – these coincide with lowest car ownership, which makes the need for good public transport more acute

### PARISH AUDIT REPORT - HEADLINES (5)

- Braunstone has a stable community, which makes a virtue of low social mobility
- Braunstone has many well-built family homes, leading to a high impact of the bedroom tax
