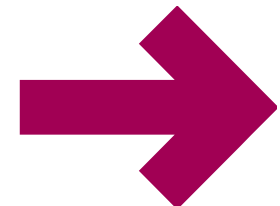

# Context

- NHS 5 year Forward View
- Organisational Capability and Capacity Programme
- Improving clinical quality and outcomes
- Compliance with clinical evidence and standards
- Improving efficiency to 'best in class'
- Improving prevention to reduce demand on complex specialised services
- Complying with due regard to protected characteristics



# What does this mean in practice ?

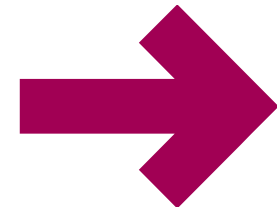
NHS England and Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCG's) will co-commission the majority of specialised services to improve integrated pathway for patients.

## 1 Proposal CCG's will commission (moving from NHS E) :

- Tier 4 bariatric surgery
- Specialised wheelchair services
- Renal dialysis
- GP referred adult out patient to Neurology Centre

## 2 Proposal NHS E will commission (moving from CCG's)

- some highly specialised adult male urological procedures
- some adult oesophageal procedures
- services for patients with homozygous familial hypercholesterolaemia
- some adult specialist haematology services
